# CODE OF CONDUCT

The salient inspiration behind the Model United Nations is to experience a collaborative and fruitful debating environment, irrespective of an individual's age, race or gender. For all members to abide, JTMUN presents the clauses of its Code of Conduct:

1. Delegates are required to display the utmost level of respect towards one another. This includes, but is not limited to, adhering to the rules of the conference and refraining from usage or depiction of any offensive, abusive or belittling language or behaviour that may harm, displease, offend or intimidate an individual or group.
2. Prohibited behaviour includes, but is not limited to, bullying, harassment, or discrimination based on race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or nationality.
3. Delegates must be dressed in formal attire; School uniforms are acceptable. Delegate cards are to be worn throughout the conference.
4. Delegates must cooperate and abide by guidelines or instructions, issued or stated, by the management of JTMUN including the ACDs and Chairs.
5. No audio, video or graphic (photos, clip-art, drawing etc.) content shall be made use of, unless approved by the management.
6. Delegates must always be in attendance, punctually and regularly. Non-adherence to schedule of committee sessions may be penalised.
7. Any delegate who intends to harm the sanctity of the debate or engages in wilful damage of school property of Lahore Grammar School JT shall be held liable.



8. Participants must keep all sensitive information discussed at the conference confidential, including informal conversations and draft resolutions. Sharing this information with outsiders is strictly prohibited.
9. In case a delegate recognises an infringement of their rights, with regard to equity guidelines, they may voice their concern to the conference organizers or the designated committee chair.
10. Delegates should respect different ideologies and perspectives, irrespective of their preconceived ideas.
11. Delegates are expected to have knowledge of Model United Nations Rules of Procedure as well as JTMUN policies. This does not imply the lack of provision of guidance and aid by the management and secretariat.
12. Failure to comply with equity guidelines will result in penalty, which may include warnings, expulsion, blacklisting, etc., in accordance with the discretion of the Executive Council. Decisions of the Executive Council are binding and irrevocable.

  - Delegation Fee: Rs. 4000
2. Regular Cycle (28th August 2024 - 22nd September 2024)
  - Delegate/Observe Fee: Rs. 4000
  - Delegation Fee: Rs. 4500

# REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

1. All the teams will be required to register via the online registration form and fill the Waiver of Liability available on our website. Hence, a valid registration.
2. The payment of the delegate fee, delegation fees and the observer fee (where applicable) must be made within a week of receiving the registration form submission confirmation email from our email address. Details and method of payment can be found within the registration form.
3. Participants must complete all registration requirements on time and double-check before final submission to avoid the risk of being excluded. Observers are required to register with their respective teams.
4. The registration team reserves the right to reject or disqualify any team/individual. Failure to adhere to the rules of the conference can lead to disqualification. JTMUN reserves the right to reject individual candidates if they fail to comply with our conference policies.
5. Each delegation may be composed of a maximum of 12 delegates. The minimum number of delegates allowed to register in a delegation is 6. These numbers include the Head Delegate.
6. Allotments will be finalised by the host team and emailed to the registered delegations within a week. Hence, committee preferences on the registration form are subject to change as per the will of the host team.
7. The allotments for UNSC will be limited to a number of 15 Delegations.
8. Leopold The Second's Cabinet and UNSC are double point committees.
9. The Best Delegation will be on the basis of individual team points. In case of a tie, the best delegation will be decided as per HMUN guidelines, which will be communicated to delegates.
10. For outstation delegations, accommodation details and information will be conveyed once the team gets in touch with our management.
